

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy sets out how Verwood Road Evangelical Chapel uses and protects any information that you give the Chapel when you use this website.

Verwood Road Evangelical Chapel is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

Verwood Road Evangelical Chapel may change this policy from time to time by updating this link. You should check from time to time to ensure that you are happy with any changes. This policy was last updated in April 2020.

WHAT WE COLLECT AND WHAT WE DO WITH THE INFORMATION WE GATHER

In general Verwood Road Evangelical Chapel does not collect or ask for any personal information about visitors to our website. In the following cases only, some information may be collected:

- In common with all modern websites, our web server stores standard log files containing information about access to the website and its resources. These log files do not contain personal data, but rather information which assists Verwood Road Evangelical Chapel in assessing the use, popularity and usability of the various pages and resources on the site. This information may include the IP address of your computer. Verwood Road Evangelical Chapel will not attempt to trace that IP address to you personally.
- We use a small number of "cookies" to enhance the user experience of the website and to help us improve our service. Full details of our use of cookies are listed in our separate cookie policy.
- On most of our web pages we include buttons enabling visitors quickly to share a particular page on various social media. The use of these buttons by our visitors does not provide Verwood Road Evangelical Chapel with any information by which you can be identified. The third-party social media services (e.g. Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn etc.) to which these buttons are linked have their own privacy policies concerning the use of information which they may or may not gather as a result of the use of these buttons by our visitors, and you are encouraged to acquaint yourself with these policies before using the buttons.
- Information provided when you submit a form or use the email address to make contact will be used to respond to your enquiry (this could be by any appropriate member of the chapel). Your contact details will also be held so that the Test and Trace service can make contact with you in the unlikely event of someone else at the Chapel contracting COVID. Your details will be kept securely and not shared with anyone else (apart from Test and Trace in the event of a COVID infection) without your explicit consent.

SECURITY

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.
